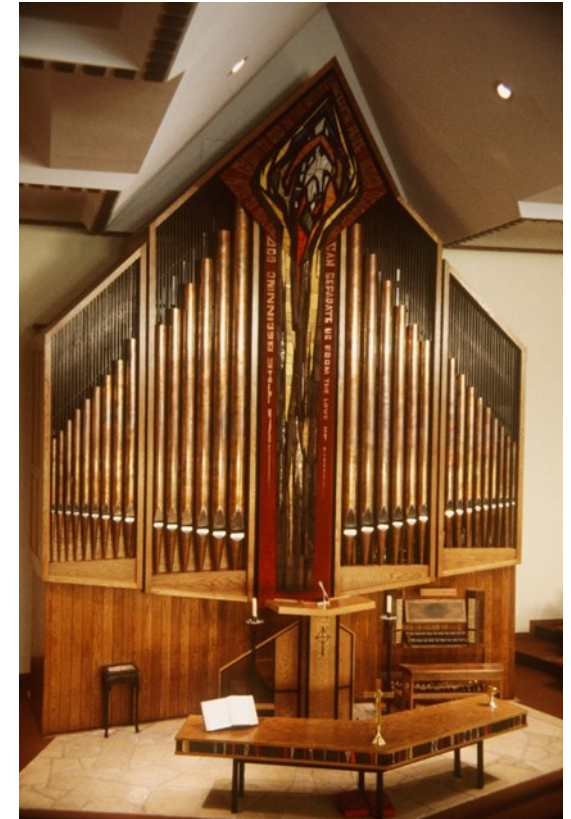

Participant Requirements

Participants between the ages of 13 and 18 are eligible to apply. Previous organ study is not required, although minimal piano proficiency at the early intermediate level is desired.

Tuition includes housing for five nights, meals (Monday evening through Saturday breakfast), transportation to and from all POE events during the week, class materials, POE T-shirt, and a one-year student membership in The American Guild of Organists. No refunds for cancellations will be made after May 21. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Travel Arrangements to and from Manhattan are the responsibility of each student.

Transportation to and from Manhattan Regional Airport (flymhk.com) will be available for those flying to and from the POE.

Housing will be provided in dormitories at Kansas State University. Rooms are single-occupancy and air conditioned. Most meals will be provided by Kramer on-campus dining center. All activities will be fully supervised by teachers and POE committee members. Please notify Dr. David Pickering, POE Director, of any special needs or accommodations that will be required.

Scholarship Assistance is available through the American Guild of Organists (ago.org/poe-scholarships); the application deadline is April 15, 2021. Scholarship decisions will be made by May 1, 2021. In addition, students may also contact AGO chapters or religious institutions if financial assistance is needed.
